## Sub: Annual Plan of Operation for the financial year 2024-25 Tamil Nadu State CAMPA.

Sir.

Kindly refer your letter No. TS5/ 26928/2023 dated 07.08.2024 on the subject. In this regard, it is informed that Annual Plan of Operation of Tamil Nadu State for the year 2024-25 was considered in 30<sup>th</sup> meeting of Executive Committee of National Authority and was approved for an amount of **Rs. 35.27 crore** against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 54.17 crore** (Table A). The approved outlay included an amount of **Rs. 22.53 crore** in respect of spill-over activities for the financial years of 2022-23 and 2023-24 as detailed in table B ref. (2).

- 2. Based on the clarification given by Tamil Nadu Forest Department, the amount of Rs. 0.837 crore earmarked against maintenance of the plantation, which is yet to be created should be treated **as not approved** for the year 2024-25. Therefore, the amount of Rs. 4.820 crore under subsection 5(2) (b) is accordingly reduced to Rs. 3.983 crore in respect of spill-over activities for the financial years of 2022-23 and 2023-24. The APO of 2024-25 is approved for total revised amount of Rs. 21.69 crore (Rupees twenty one crore and sixty nine lakh only) against an amount of Rs. 22.53 crore in respect of spill-over activities for the financial years of 2022-23 and 2023-24.
- 3. Accordingly, the revised approval of APO for Rs. 35.266 crores is given hereunder:-
