MINUTES OF THE 34th MEETING OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL CAMPA

The 34th meeting of the Executive Committee (EC) of the National CAMPA was held in Krishna Conference Room, Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, New Delhi on 23rd April, 2025 under the chairmanship of the Director General of Forests & Special Secretary (DGF&SS), MoEF&CC. The list of participants is attached at Annexure I.

PART A: GENERAL DISCUSSION AND DIRECTIONS

- 1. The Chief Executive Officer (CEO), National CAMPA welcomed the Chairman, members of the Executive Committee and other officers present in the meeting.
- The DGF&SS and the Chairman of the Executive Committee welcomed the members and other officers present in the meeting.
- The CEO informed that based on the decision taken in 33rd meeting of Executive Committee, approvals of Annual Plan of Operation of Arunachal Pradesh for the financial year 2024-25 and deferred/spill over/additional activities of Assam, Haryana, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Sikkim and Uttarakhand have been communicated.
- 4. The Director General of Forests & Special Secretary (DGF&SS) informed the Executive Committee that the Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for rejuvenation of 13 major rivers of India namely, Sutlej, Beas, Ravi, Chenab, Jhelum, Luni, Yamuna, Mahanadi, Brahmaputra, Narmada, Godavari, Krishna and Cauvery, through forestry interventions, prepared by Indian Council of Forestry Research & Education, Dehradun (ICFRE), were released by Hon'ble Minister EF&CC on 14.03.2022. The DPRs have been shared with concerned State Governments for implementation through multi-departmental participation, dovetailing with ongoing schemes like GIM, CAMPA, MNREGA, and other line departments, as no exclusive scheme exists currently. The DGF&SS directed all concerned states to furnish the status of Implementation of DPR of 13 major Rivers of India.
- The ADG, FC &WL also highlighted that till date no proposal has been received from Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Odisha, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Telangana and Uttar Pradesh regarding DPR.
- 6. The EC observed that some States have not submitted KML files of all sites taken up during 2024-25 to FSI for uploading in e-Green Watch Portal. The DGF&SS impressed upon the uploading of KML files of Plantations in e-Green Watch portal as it is essential part of monitoring. The States/UTs were directed to submit polygon/KML files of all afforestation activities to FSI for uploading in e-Green Watch Portal. The ADG, FC&WL does not agree to the approval for creation/advance work of any afforestation activity to be taken by any State, which has not submitted KML files for afforestation taken up upto 2024-25 to FSI for uploading in the e-Green Watch portal and copy to National CAMPA.

- 7. The DGF&SS advised the States/UTs to engage competent entities—such as agencies, institutes, or organizations with a proven track record and expertise in the relevant field for conducting third-party monitoring and evaluation of CAMPA works. He further urged the States/UTs to maintain a web-based platform for displaying details of CAMPA works and associated monitoring reports.
- The CEO, National CAMPA directed that all the State/UT should maintain and update their stock register regularly.
- 9. The CEO, National CAMPA informed the committee that the NCAMPA has circulated the guidelines for NPV and Interest funds. Despite several reminders, the five year perspective plan for NPV and Interest funds utilisation are yet to be received from many states/UTs. Accordingly, all concerned States/UTs were directed to submit the required details at the earliest.
